

Documents required for Financial Screening for CHP+, Medicaid, CICP, State OAP

PROOF OF IDENTITY

For CICP, CHP+, State OAP –

Proof of Identity Required for Applicants 18 years of Age or Older

- Valid Colorado State Drivers License
- Valid Colorado State Photo Identification
- United States Military Card or Military Dependents' Identification Card
- United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- Native American Tribal Document

For Medicaid –

Proof of Identity and Citizenship Required for All Applicants

The following documents can be used as proof of identification:

- State-issued Drivers License
- Federal, State, or local government-issued Photo Identification
- For Children Under 16: School ID Card, if it has a photograph
- Military dependent's ID card, if it has a photograph
- Affidavit of identification may be acceptable if no other ID is available

The following documents can prove **both** citizenship and identification:

- A U.S. Passport
- A Certificate of Naturalization (DHS Forms N-550 or N-570)
- A Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (DHS Forms N-560 or N561)

PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP/ RESIDENCY STATUS

For CICP, CHP+, State OAP –

Proof of Citizenship for Applicants 18 years of Age or Older:

- No documents are required for citizens, but ALL APPLICANTS must be present to sign affidavits, and must provide their Social Security Number
- Legal Permanent Residents and those otherwise lawfully present in the United States must be present to sign affidavits, and must provide the following documentation for all family members to which they apply:
 - o Social Security numbers
 - o Naturalization Certificates
 - o Legal Permanent Resident Cards
 - o Employment Authorization Cards
 - o I-94 Cards

For Medicaid – Proof of Citizenship Required for All Applicants

The following documents can prove citizenship, but must be accompanied by a proof of identification:

- A U.S. birth certificate.
- A Certification of Report of Birth issued by the Department of State (Form DS-1350)
- A Consular Report of Birth Abroad of a U.S. Citizen (Form FS-240)
- A Certification of Birth Abroad (FS-545)
- Final adoption decree
- An official military record of service showing a U.S. place of birth

NOTE: Other documents can be used for Medicaid proof of citizenship and identification. If you do not have any of the above documents, ask the Enrollment Department about other documents that can be used.
